The deadline for online registration is **MONDAY OCTOBER 2, 2017**. **Please include the cheques in your child's Friday folder on Monday, October 2, 2017. We are aware that this is a holiday weekend for many. If you are travelling and can't get cheques in by October 2, please register online and then contact us to make arrangement for the cheques.**

Please read the important information below regarding Lunch Program policies:

- 1. SPOTS ARE NOT GUARANTEED.** If interest exceeds program capacity, participants will be chosen by lottery from those received by the deadline. If you don't get a spot, you will have priority IN THE SAME PROGRAM in the next term. If the same program is not offered in the winter, you will get priority in ONE program of your choice. Please note: forms MUST be received BY THE DEADLINE to participate in any lottery or to receive priority in the next term. A confirmation of registration will be sent to you by email by no later than October 10, 2017.
- 2. Programs run weekly for 8 sessions.** Students must register for the full term. Fees cannot be pro-rated for student absences due to family trips, appointments, etc. There are no make-up sessions and refunds will not be given for missed sessions.
- 3. Registration Fees:** To complete your registration, please submit ONE CHEQUE PER CHILD, PER PROGRAM payable to "SUMMIT HEIGHTS SCHOOL COUNCIL" to your child's teacher. Online payment is not available at this time. If you need financial assistance to participate, please register by the deadline and then speak to your child's teacher or the principal by no later than October 6, 2017.
- 4. Behaviour Policy:** All lunch programs require students TREAT EVERYONE WITH RESPECT, LISTEN, COOPERATE WITH INSTRUCTORS, PARTICIPATE IN ACTIVITIES and HELP TO CLEAN UP. If there are behavior concerns parents will be contacted. If a parent must be contacted more than twice, the student will NOT be allowed to continue in the program. NO REFUND will be given if a student is removed from a program due to poor behavior.
- 5. Refund Policy:** We want students to be happy in the lunch programs they have chosen! If you are not happy with the chosen program, you can request a refund **before the start of the 2nd session.** REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN AFTER THE 2nd CLASS FOR ANY REASON.
- 6. "FREE" Lunch Programs:** Summit Heights teachers may offer some "free" teacher-run lunch programs or clubs in addition to the lunch programs coordinated by School Council. Details regarding any teacher-run programs will be communicated directly by the teachers involved when it is available.

TUESDAYS (October 17 - December 5)

Primary Creative Clay with WANDA! (Gr 1-3) \$140

Wanda and her crafty tools and tricks are back for her 23rd year at Summit! A long-time student favourite, Wanda will help you bring FIMO clay to life with step-by-step instructions to create some amazing projects in her fun and creative classes.

Pop Stars! (Gr 1-6) \$145
