## **PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION BELOW ABOUT SUMMIT LUNCH PROGRAM POLICIES:**

- 1. SPOTS ARE NOT GUARANTEED.** If interest exceeds program capacity, participants will be chosen by lottery. If you don't get a spot, you will be given priority in the same program next term. If the same program is not offered again, you will be given priority in ONE program of your choice next term. Forms **MUST** be received by the deadline to participate in any lotteries or to receive priority next term. Your child's participation in requested programs will be confirmed with you by email no later than January 8, 2018.
- 2. PROGRAMS RUN WEEKLY FOR 7 WEEKS.** Students must register for the full term. Fees cannot be pro-rated for family vacations or other absences. There are no make-up sessions and refunds will not be given for missed sessions.
- 3. REGISTRATION FEES:** You must submit ONE CHEQUE PER CHILD PER PROGRAM payable to "Summit Heights School Council" to your child's teacher by December 15, 2017. Online payment is NOT available at this time. *Please write the name of the program on the front of your cheque.* If you need financial assistance to participate, please speak to Mr. Mah or your child's teacher by December 15, 2017. If your cheque or a request for financial assistance is not received by the due date your request for registration may be cancelled.
- 4. BEHAVIOUR POLICY:** All programs require that students listen, behave respectfully, cooperate with instructors, follow rules, participate in activities and help to clean up. If there are behaviour concerns, parents will be contacted. If a parent has to be contacted more than twice, the student will not be allowed to continue in the program. **NO REFUND** will be given to a student removed from a program due to poor behaviour.
- 5. REFUND POLICY:** If a student is not happy in a program, a refund may be requested prior to the START of the 2nd class. NO refunds will be given after the second class for any reason.
- 6. “FREE” LUNCH PROGRAMS:** Summit teachers may offer some “free” teacher-run lunch programs or clubs in addition to the lunch programs coordinated by School Council. Details regarding these programs will be communicated directly by the teachers involved when they are available.

## **TUESDAYS** (January 16 - March 6)

### **Primary FIMO with WANDA!** (Gr 1-3) \$140

Wanda and her crafty tools and tricks are back for her 23<sup>rd</sup> year at Summit! A long-time student favourite, Wanda and her team will help you turn FIMO into some amazing and creative projects to take home!

### **Pop Stars!** (Gr 1-6) \$145

Lisa Sonshine will introduce students to the basics of song writing (melody, rhythm, chorus & verse). Participants will work together to develop lyrical themes and ideas and collaborate with each other to create their very own top-hit song. Each Pop Star will go home with a CD of their created songs.

### **DIY: Hand-Sewn Stuff** (Gr 1-6) \$115

Create a friend that is unique, fun to play with and totally you! In this Designer Co. DIY program, you will learn hand-sewing skills and get to create your very own detailed Stuff!

### **LEGO Robotics** (Gr 2-6) \$145

Working together students will learn to design, build, customize, and program their very own Lego Robot! Each week they will create a different type of robot. For the final program, students run their robot through an obstacle course to discover the ultimate Lego robot! Program brought to you by Camp Green Acres, Toronto's Premier Summer Day Camp.

## **WEDNESDAYS** (January 17 - March 7)

### **Advanced FIMO with WANDA!** (Gr 4-6) \$150

Wanda is back with all of her tricks and tools to make FIMO come to life! A more advanced course for older students, Wanda and her team will help you create a more complex and truly awesome project!

### **Build It! Lego and Structures** (Gr 1-3) \$135

This Camp Green Acres program challenges students to build creative structures using different mediums. Using Lego, Maze Runners, K'nex and other Building Tools, children will learn to create, design, plan and build. They will make cities, invent new methods of transportation, create homes of the future, animals and so much more!

### **Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them** (Gr 1-6) \$140

Hop on the Hogwarts express and step inside a world where magic is real! In this Explore-it program we explore the Magic of Hogwarts, learning the same lessons in Witchcraft and Wizardry that Harry, Ron, Hermione and Ginny did in school! Join us for an introduction to the magical beasts of the wizarding world!

### **Improv by Playworks** (Gr 2-6) \$115

This program allows born performers and those who need to break out of their shell a chance to express themselves! In the world of improv there are no "lead" roles, everyone is on the same playing field. Using improv games, Lori Pearlstein will help players learn how to act, think quickly on their feet, build self-esteem and improve public speaking. ### **Advanced FIMO with WANDA!** (Gr 4-6) \$150

### **DIY Jewelry** (Gr 1-6) \$115

With the use of jewelry pliers and a wide variety of different materials, you will develop fine motor skills, dexterity, creativity, and imagination! Over the course of 8 classes you will design and create 6-8 fabulous pieces that you can wear or share.

### **Video Game Creator** (Gr 2-6) \$145

Video Game Creator is all about creating, designing and playing your own video games. This is a great introduction to coding. Throughout the program, students will work in pairs to create a variety of different video games with multiple levels. ### **Engineering Workshop** (Gr 1-4) \$140

### **Chess** (Gr 1-6) \$105
