PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION BELOW ABOUT SUMMIT LUNCH PROGRAM POLICIES:

- 1. SPOTS ARE NOT GUARANTEED.** If interest exceeds program capacity, participants will be chosen by lottery. If you don't get a spot, you will be given priority in the same program next term. If the same program is not offered again, you will be given priority in ONE program of your choice next term. Forms **MUST** be received by the deadline to participate in any lotteries or to receive priority next term. Your child's participation in requested programs will be confirmed with you by email no later than April 6, 2018.
- 2. PROGRAMS RUN WEEKLY FOR 8 WEEKS.** Students must register for the full term. Fees cannot be pro-rated for family vacations or other absences. There are no make-up sessions and refunds will not be given for missed sessions.
- 3. REGISTRATION FEES:** You must submit ONE CHEQUE PER CHILD PER PROGRAM payable to "Summit Heights School Council" to your child's teacher by March 29, 2018. Online payment is **NOT** available at this time. *Please write the name of the program on the front of your cheque.* If you need financial assistance to participate, please speak to Mr. Mah or your child's teacher by March 29, 2018. If your cheque or a request for financial assistance is not received by the due date your request for registration may be cancelled.
- 4. BEHAVIOUR POLICY:** All programs require that students listen, behave respectfully, cooperate with instructors, follow rules, participate in activities and help to clean up. If there are behaviour concerns, parents will be contacted. If a parent has to be contacted more than twice, the student will not be allowed to continue in the program. **NO REFUND** will be given to a student removed from a program due to poor behaviour.
- 5. REFUND POLICY:** If a student is not happy in a program, a refund may be requested prior to the START of the 2nd class. NO refunds will be given after the second class for any reason.
- 6. “FREE” LUNCH PROGRAMS:** Summit teachers may offer some “free” teacher-run lunch programs or clubs in addition to the lunch programs coordinated by School Council. Details regarding these programs will be communicated directly by the teachers involved when they are available.

TUESDAYS (April 10 – May 29)

Primary FIMO by Wanda’s Creative Clay! (Gr 1-3) \$140

A long-time Summit family favourite! Wanda’s skilled team will teach you to turn FIMO clay into amazing creations designed by Wanda. Kids will improve their fine motor skills, work on patience and confidence, learn about colours and math and experience just old fashioned “having fun.”

Hip Hop Video Dance by In the Mix (Gr 1-6) \$155

Students will work collaboratively in small groups to create one-of-a kind music videos using iPads. They will have full creative freedom and will be guided appropriately to help them progress and spice up their videos and dancing. At the end of the session students can securely view their videos online.

Money Managers (Gr 4-6) \$150

An empowering financial literacy curriculum that features interactive group activities, easy-to-understand visual presentations, a “net worth” tournament, and highly charged discussions. Major topics include saving (Why should I save? How much can I save if I start now? How do I save?) and debt (What is it? How does it all work? Who exactly do I owe money to?). This course teaches students how to be financial leaders, not financial victims, and to understand how their financial choices impact not only their own lives in the short and long term but also the world around them.

WEDNESDAYS (April 11 - May 30)

HATCH (Gr 3-6) \$170

Using HATCH’s proprietary coding software, experienced instructors will help students understand the fundamentals of coding. Each week students will learn new skills and complete theme-based projects through which they learn the fundamentals of computer science. For this program only, if a student misses a class, they may arrange to make it up at a HATCH learning center on their own time.

Crazy Cooks! (Gr 1-4) \$145

The goal is for each student to develop a love of cooking! Each week they will bake, cook, create, experiment, decorate, and so much more! Whether they are creating their own smoothie concoction or decorating cupcakes, each week will be filled with tasty adventures! Crazy Cooks is a Peanut and Tree Nut safe program. NASA Academy Of Future Space Explorers (Gr 1-6) \$145

We’ve teamed up with NASA to take children on a voyage of discovery! With unique hands-on activities, amazing demonstrations, and fun experiments, this experience is truly out of this world. Children will build fun and educational take home projects to fuel their future explorations! Weekly topics include: Space Travel, Space Phenomena, Sun & Stars, Rocket Science I & II, Atmosphere & Beyond, Space Technology, and Living in Space

THURSDAYS (April 12 – May 31)**Advanced FIMO by Wanda's Creative Clay!** (Gr 4-6) \$150

Wanda's team is back with all of her tricks and tools to make FIMO clay come to life! A more advanced course for older students, Wanda's team will help you create a more complex and truly awesome project!

Co-operative Games with Jay! (Gr 1-3) \$125

Head outside with your friends to play! Structured, safe and fun games taught in a non-competitive format. This program will include a variety of warm-ups and cooperative games designed to develop children's fine and gross motor skills while having fun! Age appropriate equipment is provided.

Money Managers for Primary (Gr 1-3) \$150

An introduction to money – What is it? Where does it come from? (hint: it doesn't grow on trees!) We also cover the basics of what it means to be a consumer and the concepts of savings and debt. This class includes a financial tournament that will have the kids complaining about taxes far more than their parents!

Bling my Room! (Gr 2-6) \$145

Decorate your room with cool new accessories you made yourself! Choose from pillows, wall art, accessory organizers, memo boards, and so much more. Students will work on ongoing projects as well as bring home something new at the end of each class. (Camp Green Acres)
