### Re: New Roof Construction at SHPS

The roof at Summit Heights P.S. is going to be repaired /replaced this year. Construction will begin approximately in the middle of June 2018 and be completed within approximately 30 working days.

We are working with the contractors to ensure that construction will begin after our Senior Kindergarten Graduation and our school-wide play day have happened. The start date for construction and the completion time for the construction are subject to change, depending on weather conditions.

Over time, this roof upgrade will ensure a continued safe learning environment for our students. This is part of a major roof repair initiative that's happening in the TDSB this year. Because of the volume of school roofs being repaired this year, work must continue throughout the school year during daylight hours however, we are making every effort to do as much work outside of regular school hours as possible.

The roofing process can cause strong and unpleasant odours, which, at times, may enter the building. Please be assured that there is no risk to our students, staff, and visitors, and we are working with our facilities and health and safety teams to reduce discomfort including keeping windows and doors closed, ensuring all air intake openings are closed and that the building's ventilation system is on recirculation mode to ensure no outside air is introduced. Alternate accommodations will be made for students in the event of sensitivity to the fumes.
