Summit Heights Lunch Programs – Fall 2018

Now is your opportunity to sign up for **Fall Lunch Time Programs!** Registration will be online. A link to the registration form can be found on the Summit Heights website <http://summitheightspublicschool.com> starting at 8pm on Friday, September 21, 2018. The deadline for online registration is **MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2018**.

Please send **ONE CHEQUE PER STUDENT PER PROGRAM** and include the day and program in the memo line (for example, “Tuesday FIMO” or “Thursday Glee”).

PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION BELOW ABOUT SUMMIT LUNCH PROGRAM POLICIES:

- 1. SPOTS ARE NOT GUARANTEED.** If interest exceeds program capacity, participants will be chosen by lottery. If you don't get a spot, you will be given priority in the same program next term. If the same program is not offered again, you will be given priority in ONE program of your choice next term. Forms **MUST** be received by the deadline to participate in any lotteries or to receive priority next term. Your child's participation in requested programs will be confirmed with you by email on or around October 2, 2018.
- 2. PROGRAMS RUN WEEKLY FOR 8 WEEKS** (or specified number of weeks). Students must register for the full term. Fees cannot be pro-rated for family vacations or other absences. There are no make-up sessions, and refunds will not be given for missed sessions.
- 3. REGISTRATION FEES:** You must submit **ONE CHEQUE PER CHILD PER PROGRAM** payable to "Summit Heights School Council". Cheques are due by **Tuesday, September 25, 2018**. Online payment is NOT available at this time. If you need financial assistance to participate, please speak to Mr. Mah or your child's teacher by September 25, 2018. If your payment or a request for financial assistance is not received by the due date, your spot will be offered to any children on the wait list, and your registration may be cancelled.
- 4. BEHAVIOUR POLICY:** All programs require that students listen, behave respectfully, cooperate with instructors, follow rules, participate in activities and help to clean up. If there are behaviour concerns, parents will be contacted. If a parent has to be contacted more than twice, the student will not be allowed to continue in the program. **NO REFUND** will be given to a student removed from a program due to poor behaviour.
- 5. REFUND POLICY:** If a student is not happy in a program, a refund may be requested prior to 5pm on the day before the START of the 2nd class. NO refunds will be given after the second class.
- 6. “FREE” LUNCH PROGRAMS:** Summit teachers may offer some “free” teacher-run lunch programs or clubs in addition to the lunch programs coordinated by School Council. Details regarding these programs will be communicated directly by the teachers involved when they are available.

TUESDAYS (Oct 9- Nov 27)**Primary FIMO by Wanda's Creative Clay!** (Gr 1-3) \$140

A long-time Summit family favourite! Wanda's skilled team will teach you to turn FIMO clay into amazing creations designed by Wanda. Kids will improve their fine motor skills, work on patience and confidence, learn about colours and math and experience just old fashioned "having fun."

Little Fingers Music Keyboard Class (Gr 1-3) \$160

The "Little Fingers Music Keyboard Class" is a great introduction to "fun"amentals keyboard playing for young musicians and learners. Classes include theory, singing, and percussion as well as writing exercises; and repertoire may include the chorus of popular songs such as "We Will Rock You" (Queen), "Believer" (Imagine Dragons), and "Let It Go" (Frozen).

Sphero Robotics & Coding 101 (Gr 3-6) \$140

This program introduces students to the fun and exciting world of robotics and coding. Throughout the program students will explore how to program, customize, and control SPHERO SPRK+ Robots while learning a variety of basic, intermediate, and advanced techniques along the way! Students will also be put to the test using the Lighting Lab APP as they compete in several SPHERO Robotic challenges & competitions. Examples include: The Ultimate Programmer, The SUPER MAZE, Robot Bowling, LEGO Chariot Races, Custom built Terrain Parks, Obstacle Courses & more.

WEDNESDAYS (Oct 10- Nov 28) or (Oct 17 – Dec 5)**Advanced FIMO by Wanda's Creative Clay!** (Gr 4-6) \$150

Wanda herself is back with all of her tricks and tools to make FIMO clay come to life! A more advanced course for older students, Wanda will help you create a more complex and truly awesome project! (Oct 10- Nov 28)

Mad Science - Extraordinary Laboratory (Gr 1-6) \$145

We'll examine the world children interact with through fun and hands-on experiments, discovering the scientific principles behind it all! Your young scientist will be wowed by amazing activities and quality projects every week, exploring topics ranging from chemistry to magnets, taste buds to sound, lightning to rainbows, and so much more! Weekly topics include: Watts-Up, Magnetic Magic, Optical Illusions, Lights...Colour...Action, Chem-Mystery, Sonic Sound, Tantalizing Taste, and Harnessing Heat. **Please note that this program runs from Oct 17 – Dec 5.**

Brixology (Gr 1-6) \$145

A wide array of scientific principles will be explored through Lego builds: carnival rides, drawing machines, mechanical animals, truss bridges, and so much more.
