## **PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION BELOW ABOUT SUMMIT LUNCH PROGRAM POLICIES:**

- 1. SPOTS ARE NOT GUARANTEED.** If interest exceeds program capacity, participants will be chosen by lottery. If you don't get a spot, you will be given priority in the same program next term. If the same program is not offered again, you will be given priority in ONE program of your choice next term. Forms **MUST** be received by the deadline to participate in any lotteries or to receive priority next term. Your child's participation in the requested programs will be confirmed with you by email on or around January 3, 2019.
- 2. PROGRAMS RUN WEEKLY FOR SPECIFIED NUMBER OF WEEKS (7 or 8).** Students must register for the full term. Fees cannot be pro-rated for family vacations or other absences. There are no make-up sessions, and refunds will not be given for missed sessions.
- 3. REGISTRATION FEES:** You must submit **ONE CHEQUE PER CHILD PER PROGRAM** payable to "Summit Heights School Council". Cheques are due by ***Tuesday, December 18, 2018***. Online payment is NOT available at this time. If you need financial assistance to participate, please speak to Mr. Mah or your child's teacher by December 18, 2018. If your payment or a request for financial assistance is not received by the due date, your spot will be offered to any children on the wait list, and your registration may be cancelled.
- 4. BEHAVIOUR POLICY:** All programs require that students listen, behave respectfully, cooperate with instructors, follow rules, participate in activities and help to clean up. If there are behaviour concerns, parents will be contacted. If a parent has to be contacted more than twice, the student will not be allowed to continue in the program. **NO REFUND** will be given to a student removed from a program due to poor behaviour.
- 5. REFUND POLICY:** If a student is not happy in a program, a refund may be requested prior to 5pm on the day before the START of the 2nd class. **NO refunds will be given after the second class.**
- 6. “FREE” LUNCH PROGRAMS:** Summit teachers may offer some “free” teacher-run lunch programs or clubs in addition to the lunch programs coordinated by School Council. Details regarding these programs will be communicated directly by the teachers involved when they are available.

## **TUESDAYS** (Jan 15- Mar 5)

### **Little Fingers Music Keyboard Class** (Gr 1-3) \$160

The "Little Fingers Music Keyboard Class" is a great introduction to the keyboard for young learners. Students learn basic keyboard skills, read notes and rhythms, complete written theory exercises and sing a variety of songs. Keyboards are supplied, and classes are designed by Little Fingers Music founder and composer, Charlie Kert, and taught by qualified music teachers.

### **Primary FIMO by Wanda's Creative Clay!** (Gr 1-3) \$140

A long-time Summit family favourite! Wanda will teach you to turn FIMO clay into amazing creations designed by Wanda. Kids will improve their fine motor skills, work on patience and confidence, learn about colours and math and experience just old fashioned "having fun."

### **Video Game Design** (Gr 1-6) \$140

This program is designed to challenge students in a fun, non-competitive environment as they design and create their own unique video games. Throughout the program, students will create up to 5 different video games. For each game, they'll learn how to add characters, obstacles, backgrounds, and multiple skill levels. Students will also be able to fully customize their title pages, high-score boards, instruction pages and cheat codes. At the end of the program each student will receive a copy of everyone's video games to take home on a brand new USB key.

**WEDNESDAYS** (Jan 16- Mar 6)**Magical Magicians** (Gr 1-4) \$130

Abracadbra! Join us to explore the mystical world of magical arts and theatricality. Magic offers amazement, excitement, and mystery; but it must also entertain those you are performing for. You may already know a simple card trick or two – but can you make it come to life onstage? With us, you'll learn loads of tricks – maybe how to make cards appear, coins disappear or read people's minds - but we'll also teach you how to entertain a crowd! If you've always wanted to get onstage and mystify an audience, this is the program for you! Join us for a truly magical experience! **Please note this is a seven-week program and runs from Jan 23 – Mar 6.**

**Young Jedis** (Gr 3-6) \$130

Join us to train in the ways of the Jedi and fulfill your destiny! In this multidisciplinary, creative crafts and games program, students will create their own Jedi character, engage in Jedi training games, learn about our galaxy and those far, far away; and of course, learn to wield a lightsaber safely before receiving their Jedi certificate. Imaginations will soar in this action packed weekly adventure. May the force be with you! **Please note this is a seven-week program and runs from Jan 23 – Mar 6.**

**Brixology** (Gr 1-6) \$145

In this program children will build a different LEGO® project each week. Each program has been developed by a LEGO® Certified Professional. Mechanical engineering will be explored as students build boats and vehicles. Aerospace engineering will come alive as they assemble a space station. A wide array of scientific principles will be explored through Lego builds: carnival rides, drawing machines, mechanical animals, truss bridges, and so much more. Your future engineer will foster their creativity through fun and hands-on design challenges. Let the tinkering begin! Weekly topics include: Aerospace, Carnivals, Creatures, Vehicles, Towers, Boats, Bridges, and Machines.

**Money Managers** (Gr 4-6) \$145

The course that turns learning basic financial literacy upside down – from boring and tedious, to fun and inspiring! Be warned, however, that this program will also turn your home life upside down – from “Mom, Dad, give me money,” to “Mom, Dad, give me money for my RESP!”

Major topics include:

- DEBT: What is it? How does it all work? Who exactly do I owe money to?
- Credit scores, credit cards, student loans, lines of credit, mortgages, payday loans, and taxes are thoroughly examined.

Also covered: what it really costs parents to keep their little darlings clothed, fed, and programmed for one year, as well as an outline of life's big expenses, like education, real estate and retirement.

In an era filled with unrelenting consumer advertising, false images of financial success, and easily accessible credit, this course teaches students how to be financial leaders, not financial victims; to be true to who they are when they manage their finances; and to understand how their financial choices impact not only their own lives in the short and long term, but also the world around them.

**THURSDAYS** (Jan 17- Mar 7)**Advanced FIMO by Wanda's Creative Clay!** (Gr 4-6) \$150

Wanda herself is back with all of her tricks and tools to make FIMO clay come to life! A more advanced course for older students, Wanda will help you create a more complex and truly awesome project!

**Hand-Sewing 101: DIY Little Miss or Mr. Man Stuffy** (Gr 1-6) \$120

Little Miss Chatterbox is known for talking a lot, and Mr. Happy is known for smiling and spreading joy! In this DesignHer program, you will learn skills and techniques to create a simple pattern, and hand-sew a Little Miss or Mr. Man stuffy that is unique, fun to play with, and totally you! We'll supply the materials and you bring your creativity!

**Junior Musical Theatre** (Gr 1-4) \$130

A first-time theatre experience for future stars of the stage! In small groups students will have fun acting out stories, engaging in role play, singing, and dancing. Whether shy or outgoing, students will blossom in this performing arts program, which builds confidence, encourages creative self-expression, and improves listening and speaking skills. We promote self-expression without embarrassment and foster independent thinking in a teamwork environment. Every child's voice is heard! ***Please note this is a seven-week program and runs from Jan 23 – Mar 6.***

**FRIDAYS** (Jan 11 – Mar 8, *NO CLASS ON JAN 18 OR FEB 15*)**Primary FIMO by Wanda's Creative Clay!** (Gr 1-3) \$125

**Chess** (Gr 1-6) \$115

Chess and Math Association (CMA) is a Canada-wide, non-profit organization dedicated to bringing the game of chess into elementary schools. Studies have shown that playing chess improves children's quality of life, mathematical skills and intelligence! Come learn to play!

**Yoga and Mindfulness** (Gr 1-6) \$125

**Digital Photography** (Gr 1-6) \$135

Using top of the line digital cameras, going on scavenger hunts, and playing photography themed games is all in the fun of this photographic workshop. Students will also learn how to edit, enhance, and crop their photos using top of the line photo editing software. All photos will be used to create a variety of themed Slide Show movie creations throughout the program. Students will learn how to add titles, music, and voice recordings to truly make their slide show movies their own. At the end of the program, each student will take home all their photo slide show movies and photo stills on a brand new USB key.
